Nurses, clinical scientists, research scientists and others with a demonstrable professional interest in HCAIs are also a vital part of our membership network.

Applications are subject to review and approval by the HIS Finance Committee and Council, reflecting the importance and seriousness with which the Society approaches all corporate relationships.



# Corporate Partner Principles

- We think industry offers important solutions to IPC
- We want to work with industry to facilitate learning about these solutions by HIS members
- We are partnering with industry through corporate partnerships to facilitate this process. Partners pay for these corporate partnerships. Income derived is used for HIS activities which benefit members, including supporting HIS to facilitate learning about industry solutions.
- We recognise the potential for, and perception that commercial partnership may influence HIS activity and therefore we limit the potential for commercial sponsors' influence by:
  - Ensuring we have multiple corporate partners
  - Ensuring we are not reliant on corporate partner funding
  - Ensuring corporate funding from any one partner is not overly influential to HIS funding
  - Ensure clear and pre-defined packages defining activities associated with funding
  - Declaring all corporate partners
  - Not allowing partners to influence activity outside of pre-defined packages
  - Vetting partners through rigorous application process
